General Guidelines:

- All units in the parade must be identified. If possible, please include a sign for each participating group.
- All persons riding on floats or vehicles shall only do so in a safe and reasonable manner, taking into consideration the movement of the floats and vehicles.
- Maximum float size is 10'x 30'- Milton Freewater streets will not accommodate larger entries for turning.
- All parade participants shall arrive at check-in area, no later than 10:50 am in order to allow parade staff to coordinate the lineup and start the parade on time.
- Parade participants will be notified of additional parade-day details or changes as the date draws nearer so please be sure to include an email address on your application.
- No discharging of firearms of any kind.
- If horses or other animals are a part of your float, you will be responsible for cleaning up after them (a diaper is recommended).

OPERATING A VEHICLE:

- All drivers must have a current driver's license and a copy of a valid vehicle insurance verification at the time of the parade.
- No person operating a vehicle or other moving equipment shall be permitted to operate a cellular device, including no texting, while in the parade route.
- All drivers must have a clear and unobstructed view in all directions.
- All drivers must have complete control of moving equipment at all times.
- All drivers must maintain a forward motion at all times. Drivers cannot slowdown in order to speedup.
- All persons riding on floats or vehicles shall only do so in a safe and reasonable manner, taking into consideration the movement of the floats and vehicles.
- No participant may leave the float, vehicle or entry at any time prior to the conclusion of the parade route. (They may not switch from riding the float to walking to riding the float again)
- Helmets must be worn by any rider/passenger under the age of 18 years on any scooter, go cart, motorcycle, ATV or any similar motorized vehicle or device.
- Participants are required to yield right of way to all emergency vehicles.

PROMOTIONAL/CANDY HANDOUTS:

- Participants shall not throw, handout or project by any means, any items from parade entries. However, participants on foot are allowed to hand out candy and/or promotional items before and/or during the parade using the sidewalk and/or within 3 feet of the curb.
- Items may only pass from hand-to-hand. Under no circumstances are items to be thrown or tossed anywhere along the parade route.
